Mount Victory Historic District

The village's main business block is part of the Mount Victory Historic District listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The district includes 26 buildings that represent the vernacular architecture of a rural community at the turn of the century when our country was being forged primarily by road and rail.

Mount Victory was built around the railroad and the crossing on Main Street is the perfect place to stand or sit and train watch. The tracks run through the main business block and are some of the busiest in the state so you don't have to wait too long for the next locomotive to come by where enthusiasts can see them close up and eye level.
